Unplug the IAC valve located on the passenger side, rear of the throttle body. Start the engine. Insert a T-30 size Torx driver into the Idle adjustment screw that is located behind the plug removed earlier. Turn the screw to adjust the idle speed to 650 RPM +/- 50 RPM.

Turn the idle speed screw clockwise with a screwdriver until the motor starts to stall and turn it back counterclockwise 3/4-turn. If the engine stalls, start the motor again. Turn the idle mixture adjustment screw counterclockwise until the vacuum gauge is reading about 1900 rpm for the 50-cc engine or about 1400 rpm for the 150-cc engine.

Adjusting Your Minimum Air (or Idle Speed) Before continuing, we recommend you clean your IAC valve. What you will need is a paperclip, torx screwdriver (T-25) to make adjustments and an accurate RPM gauge. If you can afford a diagnostic RPM gauge, we recommend that as the dashboard gauge isn't exactly calibrated for tune up type of jobs.

### Adjusting Your Minimum Air (or Idle Speed) - IROC - Zone

Locate the idle-adjustment screw on the Ryobi trimmer. On the four-cycle Ryobi, the idle adjustment screw is directly below the primer bulb. On the two-cycle Ryobi, the adjustment screw is through the air-filter cover. You do not need to remove the cover to access the adjustment screw.

Gently push the linkage rearward to take the pressure off and turn the idle screw counter clockwise (up) to increase idle speed, turn the idle screw clockwise (down) to decrease idle speed. Check the RPM and adjust idle speed screw until the correct idle speed is achieved. Vehicle should be in gear (if automatic) with the AC on.
