The overall mean score of knowledge for the students was 4.36 ± 0.39 . Ayepola et al.(2018) found the mean knowledge score as 5.51 ± 0.14 (out of 10).[24] Jairoun et al.(2019) found the total knowledge attitude and practice (KAP) score pertaining to antibiotic use as 56 (on a scale of 0-100).[26]

The mean score for each scale were as follows: knowledge (29.73 ± 9.06), attitude (6.63 ± 1.96), practice (35.25 ± 8.3) and barriers (1.57 ± 0.95). Better attitude ($r = 0.244$) and practice ($r = 0.264$) were significantly associated with better knowledge.
