He received the Nobel Prize in Economics in 1978 and the Turing Award in 1975.

In his influential book Administrative Behavior (1947), Simon sought to replace the highly simplified classical approach to economic modeling—based on a concept of the single decision-making, profit-maximizing entrepreneur—with an approach that recognized multiple factors that contribute to decision making.

He proposed a new concept of administration which is based upon purely factual statements in Administrative science. That is why he calls traditional concept of Administration as proverbs & myths.

Simon has given the concept of administrative man as the model of decision-making. The model is based on the following assumptions: (i) Administrative man adopts satisfaction approach in decision-making rather than the maximizing approach of economic man. Herbert Simon made key contributions to enhance our understanding of the decision-making process. In fact, he pioneered the field of decision support systems. According to (Simon 1960) and his later work with (Newell 1972), decision-making is a process with distinct stages. He suggested for the first time the decision-making model of human beings.

Satisficing is a decision-making strategy or cognitive heuristic that entails searching through the available alternatives until an acceptability threshold is met. The term satisficing, a portmanteau of satisfy and suffice, was introduced by Herbert A. Simon in 1956, although the concept was first posted in his 1947 book Administrative Behavior.
