There are five international treaties underpinning space law, overseen by the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (UNCOPUOS). The signing of the Outer Space Treaty in 1967.

International Space Law - Space Foundation

The 1967 Outer Space Treaty, to which Australia is a party, prohibits the placement in orbit around the Earth of any nuclear weapons or any other kinds of weapons of mass destruction. Additionally, it prohibits the placement of such weapons on celestial bodies or the stationing of such weapons in outer space.

Star Laws: Legal Controls on Armed Conflict in Outer Space ...

The Outer Space Treaty does not ban military activities within space, military space forces, or the weaponization of space, with the exception of the placement of weapons of mass destruction in space. It is mostly a non-armament treaty and offers insufficient and ambiguous regulations to newer space activities such as lunar and asteroid mining.

There are two types of space law: international space law and national space law. International space law is part of international law akin to the law of the high seas or the Antarctic treaty regime. It is a set of agreements, written or unwritten, legally binding and not (so-called soft law) which guides and governs the activities of states in outer space.

These five treaties deal with issues such as the non-appropriation of outer space by any one country, arms control, the freedom of exploration, liability for damage caused by space objects, the safety and rescue of spacecraft and astronauts, the prevention of harmful interference with space activities and the environment, the notification and registration of space activities, scientific investigation and the exploitation of natural resources in outer space and the settlement of disputes.

Space Law Treaties and Principles - UNOOSA

In 1959 a permanent Outer Space Committee was formed for the purpose of maintaining the United Nations Charter and other international law in space, which opened the way for peaceful exploration. In 1963 the Nuclear Test Ban Treaty was signed, followed by an Outer Space Committee resolution to prohibit nuclear weapons testing in space.
