If you're using a Mac that's running macOS Catalina, go to the Apple menu and choose Lock Screen or press Command+Control+Q. This will lock your Mac and return you to the Login screen. For older versions of the operating system, press Control+Shift+Power button (or Control+Shift+Eject if your Mac has an optical drive). It will lock the screen.

Head to Applications > Utilities > Keychain Access. From the "Keychain Access" menu, select the "Preferences" command. In the "Preferences" window, check the "Show keychain status in menu bar" option. You'll now see a lock icon on your menu bar. Click it and you'll see the option to lock your screen.

Boot up your Mac, and you should not see the firmware lock again. Disable the Password With Firmware Password Utility. Restart your Mac while holding down the Command + R keys to enter Recovery Mode. When the Utilities screen appears, go the Utilities menu bar, and select "Firmware Password Utility". Choose to turn the Firmware Password off.

If you right-click the app's menu bar icon, you'll see a menu that lets you set how long KeepingYouAwake should keep an idle system awake. Select a duration that suits you, and click the app icon to activate it. Once activated, you can lock your screen and it won't be put to sleep.

### How to disable lock screen sleep on macOS

You can switch screens by using the Application Switcher. Press Command+Tab to move to the next screen; or Press and hold Command+Tab then use the arrow keys to move right and left along the row of app icons. You can also hold down the Control key and press the left or right arrow keys to move between full-screen apps.
