Schon's theory of reflective practice was developed in his seminal book 'The Reflective Practitioner: How Professionals Think in Action', first published in 1983 and then republished in 1991. Unlike Kolb's (1984) reflective theory , Schon's theory is not a multi-stage or circular model of reflection.

The reflective practitioner One of Donald Schon's greatest contributions to professional education was to stress the role of reflection within the learning process (Schon 1983). Examining professional practice, Schon identified two types of reflection: reflection-in-action and reflection-on-action.

Schon alone, were The Reflective Practitioner, published in 1983,9 and Educating the Reflective Practitioner, published in 1987.10 With one exception,1 none of Schbn's other books pursued the themes of effective decision-making and professional problem-solving.
